I am pleased to inform you that the once a year, compulsory junior leadership appointment training course, - Sixers' Training Course, is now open for registration! Details will be as follows:

Date of Event: 21 Nov 09 (Sat) – 23 Nov 09 (Mon)

Time: 09.00am (Sat) – 12.00pm (Mon)

Venue: Sarimbun Scout Camp

Payment: **SGD\$40** per participant. All payment are preferred to be made in cheque payable to '**The Singapore Scout Association**' to facilitate the procurement of equipment; and or to be made through Unit Fund.

Cost will includes meals and refreshments, course badge, certificate; course t-shirts will be based on availability on economy of scale based on participation rate

Eligibility: For all existing Asst. Sixers and Sixers. Potential Cadet Scouts (at least Pri 4 and above) taking over the appointments may be considered.

Closing Date: forms to reach organizer by **31 Oct 09**.

Course Capacity: **Maximum 120 Cadet Scouts**. Application based on first come first come basis.

The Sixers' Training Course is based on the concept of 'Six System' and will be conducted in Camp. The Course is designed to develop junior appointment holders' confidence; self-reliance and leadership. Training will

be done through role plays, teambuilding and initiative games. Training methods will be of non-formal education.

Unit Leaders are to arrange own or collative transportation for their boys to the training ground.

Unit Leaders are to collate the applicants' Indemnity Form and submit together with the Course Application Form and Indemnity Form by **31 Oct 09** for indications of participation. Course payment should be made **before** the closing date to confirm applications.

2. Unit Leaders or parent volunteers are to assist in running the camp (Duties will be assigned one week before the camp.)
